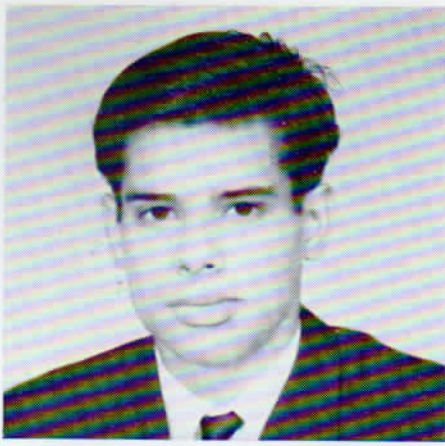

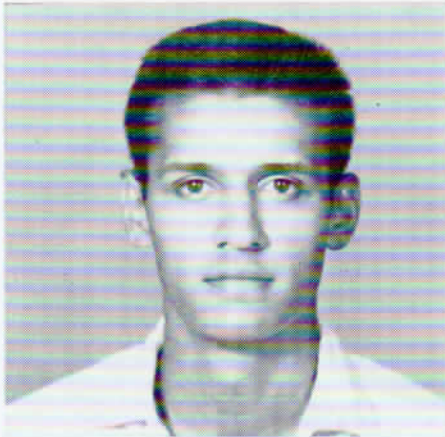


### **ANIL NAYAR**

Age 22 and a student at St. Steven's College in New Delhi. Has been playing squash since 1955 and won the All India, Western India and Eastern India Championships in 1966.

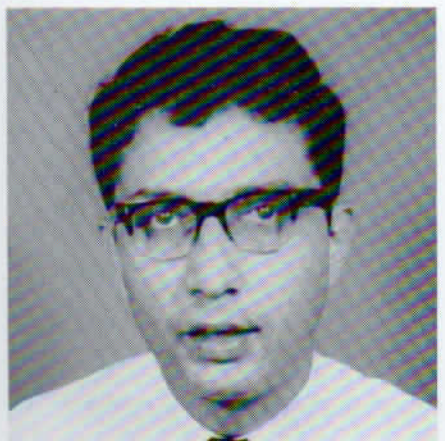

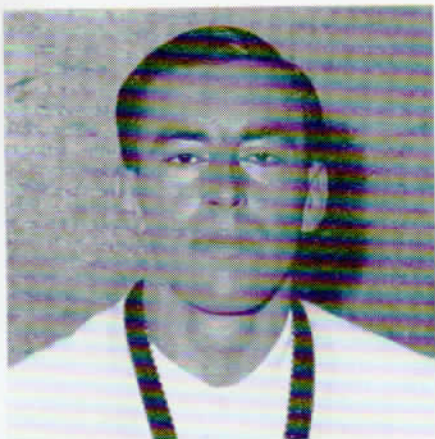

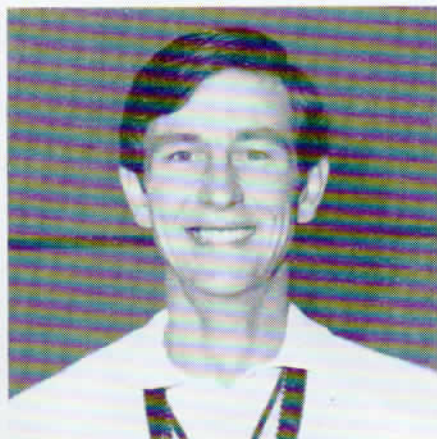


### **JONAH BARRINGTON**
