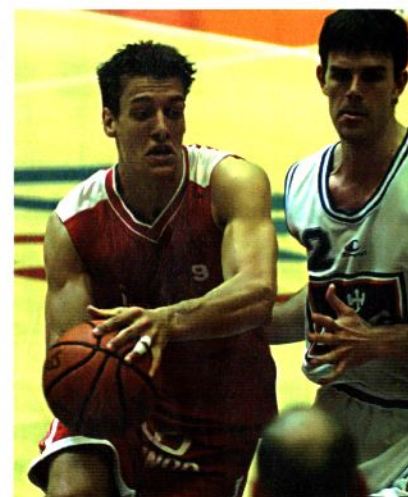

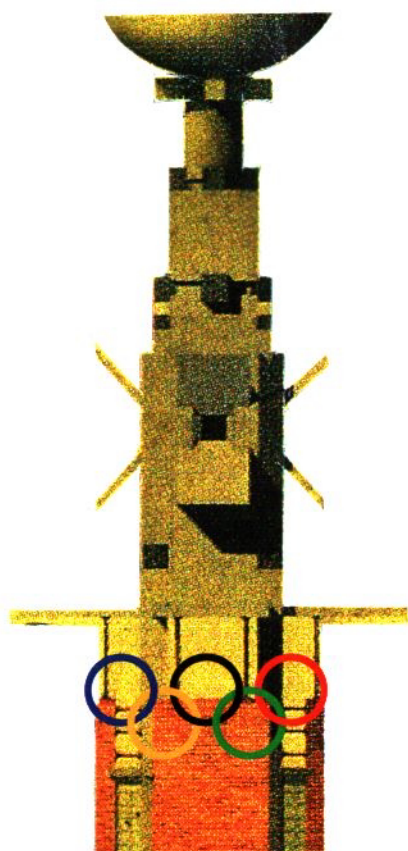

I would like to welcome all teams participating in these World Women's Team Championships, the pinnacle of Dutch squash in 2004.

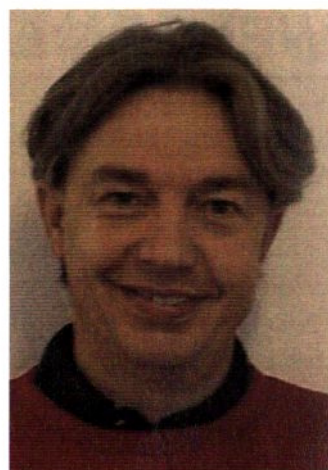
